We Give for Him

God’s goodness abounds! We are blessed to partner with several foundations and many donors whose gifts this school year alone total more than half-a-million dollars and provide our students with work-matching scholarships, program enhancements, and facility improvements.

In just the **PAST** 10 months, funded entirely by donations, we have:

- Installed duct socks and repaired the gymnasium ceiling
- Mounted a new sound system in the gym
- Built a 97 x 30 foot green house with fans and thermostat
- Erected a new scoreboard on the soccer field
- Purchased TI-Inspire calculators for math, uniforms for the girls basketball team, robotics kits for a new course, and new music equipment for the chapel
- Partnered with an instructional coach to grow our teachers
- Repurposed & remodeled two rooms into music studios
- Provided professional college/career counseling for our juniors

At **PRESENT**, we are working on these already funded projects:

- Design and install directional signage to campus
- Remodel the restrooms near the chapel
- Finish gym and lobby renovations

Our **PROSPECTS** are abundant. As we look to the future, we see a:

- Upgrades in security (doors, lighting, cameras)
- Parking lot at corner of Sanitarium & Academy Road
- Improvements on the field (pitching, bleachers, pavilion, etc.)
- Continuous advancement in student engagement and learning
- Renovated 20 unit apartment complex, funded by a third-party sustainability partner
- New STEM building for our students to grow skills and interest in science, technology, engineering, and math
- Outdoor chapel on Founders Hill
